#### March 30

We used a drone of Ken Michitsch's to recon the end of West Shore Drive's lake area for geese nests. We had limited success at controlling the drone due to the winds. We have footage on an android phone, but it did not show any new nests.

#### March 31

We launched a boat to tour the lake for geese's nests. We located three nests on the lower and middle of the lake. This was followed by two on the upper end of the lake. We were limited to were we could go on the upper end by the depth of the water and stumps with the boat we were using on the end of West Shore Drive.

### April 2

Members met at Boat Basin four to launch two small boats to get into the wet land area on the end of West Shore Drive. After two hours of rowing around obstructions, two nests were located. One has seven eggs already in the nest. We hope to revisit these nests next week for addling of the eggs.

We addled one nest with seven eggs on the wet land at the end of West Shore Drive.

### April 9

Members and volunteers met at the office to discuss the number of boats and persons available for Saturday's addling of the eggs Weather was in the thirties and snowing.

## April 10

Several nests with eggs were found on the lake and the eggs were replaced with potatoes.

#### April 13

Two new nests were spotted, one at boat basin number two and one on a island on the East Shore Drive side. Both nest had no eggs. We will check back on this site this weekend to look for new eggs.

Boat Basin docks number three and swimming platform were installed in the morning. On the upper end wet lands of West Shore Drive three nest were marked with orange poles and are to be revisited next week for signs of new eggs.
